# Justifications

- **It is a close placing between C and A.**
  - C shows more arch and height through her loin and into her pelvis.
  - Neater about the tail head.
  - More depth of fore rib and dairy characteristics in the front.
  - More evenly balanced in rear quarters.
- **A goes over B.**
  - Levelness of udder from front to rear.
  - Mammary system high about her hock.
  - Flatter dairy bone.
- **B goes over D.**
  - Better height and width of rear udder.
  - Leaner and more dairy through head and neck.
  - Longer body.
  - Lacks overall quality to be higher in the class.
